

RULES OF EXAMINATION, GRADING AND PROMOTION

1. **Examinations.** In each Academic Year, the school will hold the following test:-

- (a) Evaluation (EV) 1, 2, 3 for Class I to V.
- (b) Periodic Test (PT) 1, 2, 3 for Class VI to X
- (c) Unit Test (UT) I & 2 for Class XI & XII.
- (d) Half Yearly (HY).
- (e) Preparatory Test (PT).
- (f) Pre Board (PB).
- (g) Annual Examination (AE).

2. **Grading.**

(a) For Classes I to V, 5 point grading system to be adopted as under :-

S/No	Grade	Remark	Percentage
(i)	A+	Outstanding	90% - 100%
(ii)	A	Excellent	75% - 89%
(iii)	B	Very Good	56% - 74%
(iv)	C	Good	35%– 55%
(v)	D	Scope for Improvement	Below 35%

(b) For Classes VI to XII:-

- (i) For Scholastic, 9 point grading will be followed as given by the Board.
- (ii) For Co-scholastic Area and Activities, 5 point area will be followed as given by the Board.

3. **Pass Percentages.**

(a) For Class I to VIII, no detention.

(b) **For Class IX & X:-**

- (i) 33% marks out of 80 marks in each subject in Annual Examination(Board Examination for class X).
- (ii) 33% marks out of 20 marks in each subject in Internal Assessment.

(c) **For Class XI & XII.** Candidate should obtain not less than 33% marks in each subject. In case of a subject involving practical work, a student must obtain 33% marks in theory and 33% mark in practical separately in addition to 33% mark in aggregate in order to qualify in the subject.

4. **Attendance.** A pupil may not be allowed to sit in the annual examination if he/she has not put in a minimum 75% of total attendance in the Academic Session, including attendance in previous school, if the student has been admitted on transfer.

Note. A pupil, who fails to appear in the Annual Examination even though he/she had secured sufficient mark in periodical test and half yearly examination, will be deemed to have failed in the Annual Examination and shall not be promoted to the next higher class. Where, however, the absence from the annual examination was due to reasons beyond the control of the pupil, he/she will be given a supplementary examination.
